
Start an Idea bank

- •Keep an idea bank
- this is a list of ideas
- to use for future content





Start a Template Bank



Keep a file of templates into which you can plug information to create new content or repurpose old content.



The List Post



List posts are nice because they're easy for readers to digest and simple for you to make.



What can you list?



You can list anything, including tips, tools, resources, people to follow, blogs to read, and so on.




Numbers in your Title



Numbering your list items and putting this number in the title makes your list more attractive to readers.



Item Number



You can create long lists with just a blurb for each item or short lists that say more about each item.
