

Module 4 Cheat Sheet – Customise Your Pitch and Get Booked

Key Takeaways:

- Every podcast is different so be prepared to tweak your pitch email to suit the needs of the audience
- Once you get a booking, follow up with the host to find out what happens next and what they need from you

Customize Your Pitch

- ✓ You need to provide maximum value and impact for your host and audience
- ✓ Do more research on your fist-priority podcasts:
 - \circ $\,$ What the podcaster has been doing lately
 - What's going on in their market
 - What their audience has been talking about (e.g. on social media)
 - What's in the news about your topic

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- ✓ Customise your expertise for that audience
 - What unique information can I teach their audience?
 - What interesting story will their audience benefit from hearing?
 - \circ $\,$ What new piece of knowledge can I share with the listeners?
 - ✓ Customize your incentive to the podcaster's audience
 - ✓ Customize your pitch email

Approach Your List and Get Booked

- $\checkmark\,$ Before you start sending emails, check once more that the email is:
 - Personalised
 - \circ Customised
- ✓ Not everyone replies right away
- ✓ Follow up your first email request at 7 days, 10 days, and 30 days
- $\checkmark\,$ Add additional value in your follow-up emails, e.g.
 - \circ $\,$ Share links to other podcast episodes you've been on
 - \circ $\,$ Share social proof in the form of testimonials from customers $\,$
 - Share links to articles you've written that align with one of the topics you pitched
- ✓ If there's no answer, mark them as "not interested" on your spreadsheet



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When You Get Booked

- $\checkmark~$ Once booked, follow up the booking with each host to check details
- ✓ Create an Interview Preparation Document
- $\checkmark~$ Each show host has their own style when it comes to questions
- ✓ Some prefer you to provide questions
- $\checkmark\,$ Some want to provide the questions to you
- $\checkmark~$ Ask them what they are likely to ask
- \checkmark Do they want you to send in a bio?



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
