What Tech Do You Need?

- ✓ You don't need to spend a fortune on equipment
- ✓ But you need good enough material to produce a professional sound
- ✓ Most important are your microphone and headphones or earpiece
- ✓ Have a camera for video podcasting
- ✓ Your total outlay on equipment will be \$150 - \$200
- ✓ Don't use your computer's built-in camera





- ✓ Check that you have fast Wi-Fi and phone connections
- ✓ Investing in quality materials is worth it in the long run
- ✓ Check everything works, then check again 60 minutes before the interview
- ✓ Have back-up plan with your host in case of tech glitches
- ✓ Outsource anything technical if you don't feel confident

Prepare your environment

- ✓ You have control of your environment
- ✓ Have a dedicated space for your interviews
- ✓ No extraneous noises which can distract the audience
- ✓ Dampen hard sound with pillows, towels, etc.
- ✓ No dogs, kids, or other interruptions
- ✓ Turn off devices and notifications on your computer
- ✓ Turn off your phone
- ✓ Shut down all other apps using your internet
- ✓ If at home, get others off the internet
